The Most Hypocritical Time of the Year

It just may be that this time of year reveals hypocrisy at its height. There is more vocal admiration for Jesus than at any other time. There will be more people who will attend a church and appear to worship God at this time than at any other.

However, just seven days after the day that they will proclaim the birth of Jesus (in spite of the evidence that He was not born on this day and in spite of the lack of authority for observing His birth day specially), these same people will party to the coming of the new year engaging in all kinds of sordid activities.

Hypocrisy is on display clearly in Matthew 23. There Jesus confronted those of His day who displayed hypocrisy in every phase of their lives. They were the rulers and leaders of the people. They were the learned and wise men in the word of God. Jesus even told the Jews, "Therefore whatever they tell you to observe, that observe and do, but do not do according to their works for they say, and do not do." (verse 3)

Jesus exposed their specific acts of hypocrisy in Matthew 6. He pointed to their display of religiosity in public. These people paraded themselves in front of the crowds when they practiced some parts of their religion. They sounded a trumpet in order to attract attention when they gave bags of money to the poor. And, they used public prayer to impress others as they used many words and vain repetitions to increase the length and depth of these audible displays of hypocrisy. I wonder how Jesus would respond today were He to see all that takes place at this time of year. Would He call attention to the manger scenes of the wise men worshipping at His birth and wonder why so many honor that worship now but not again until next year at the same time? Would He reference the public playing of songs that tell of the young King who has come into the world and wonder why He is King only at this time of year?

Would He be impressed with all of the giving that takes place during this time or would He wonder why giving is not a priority all year long? Would He appreciate the emphasis on everyone being good (because Santa is coming to town) or would He think how materialistic we have become? I don't think He is very impressed with our hypocrisy.
